
# NEED ACCOMMODATIONS ON THE ACT?





## 1) GO TO WWW.MYACT.ORG

- If you don't have an account, click on Create MyACT account and follow the prompts.
- If you have an account, sign in with your email and password.




#### 2) LINK YOUR HIGH SCHOOL




#### 3) START THE REGISTRATION PROCESS!



# On the homepage, click register for the ACT.

 Make sure you have all materials ready (otherwise, you'll have to start over!)

- Test in the U.S., US territories, or Puerto Rico.
- In school, test with standard time or up to time-and-a-half extended time.
- Use a regular (10-point type) or large (18-point type) Test Booklet or Browser Zoom for online testing.
- Test with an approved bilingual dictionary, if needed.

- You need more than 50% time extension or require testing over multiple days.
- You use alternate test formats such as braille, prerecorded audio, or a computer for essays.

#### 4) CHOOSE YOUR TESTING CONDITIONS

Choose to take the ACT with writing or the ACT, no writing.



Choose ACT with writing if you are planning on applying to one of the very few schools that require at least one attempt on the writing section, including:

- Martin Luther College (MN)
- West Point (NY)
- University of Mary Hardin-Baylor (TX)
- Montana Christian College (MT)

Many universities don't require the Writing section, but many use it for English placement. Check each university's website for information on the ACT Writing Test—don't trust outside sources!

#### Choose paper-based or computer-based testing (CBT).

- The computer-based test is not available at all test centers or on all test dates.
- The computer-based test is the **same test** as on paper, just on a computer screen.

Note: Taking the ACT on a computer is currently in a pilot state and test centers are limited. Your zip code may not show results until availability is expanded. Paper and pencil testing is still an option through your preferred test center.




Note: Based on the zip code you provided, the nearest computer testing center is approximately 4 miles from you.

\*If you require **special testing**, choose your testing timeframe. You will work with your school to coordinate exact testing dates.









#### 5) FINALIZING YOUR TEST REGISTRATION

Add this date to your calendar. **Set an alert for 1 week prior** to check on its status!












### 5) FINALIZING YOUR TEST REGISTRATION (CONT.)

(You can also input this information later if desired.)








## Where should we send your scores?

You can add up to 6 recipients to receive your scores right when they are available. The first 4 are free! List in order of preference (1 = most preferred).


Under College Choices, input score recipients later (AFTER you receive all test scores) to make an informed decision.

Adjust your **Notification Preferences,** and input **parent details** if desired.



#### 6) REQUESTING YOUR ACCOMMODATIONS

Check your inbox from an email from ACT about **completing your ACT** accommodations/supports request.

- Complete the form Consent to Release Information to ACT.
- Forward this email to your school's **ACT accommodations** coordinator.
  - Your school official is responsible for submitting your accommodations request before the late registration deadline.

#### Your school official will be notified of ACT's decision.

- If your request is not approved, you can work with your counselor to appeal ACT's decision.
- If you have not received an update after 10 business days, contact your school official directly!

#### 7) APPROVED FOR **SPECIAL TESTING\*?**

\*Special testing includes time extensions more than 50% (including multi-day testing) and alternate test formats (including braille and text-to-speech).

- ACT will not schedule your test dates for you; you and your school
  official are responsible for coordinating your specific testing schedule.
- Most students approved for special testing can test at their school, but if this is not possible, **contact ACT as soon as you can.**
